MEMORANDUM FOR A Company, WTB-ERMC, Unit 23152, APO AE 09227

SUBJECT: Policy Letter #3, Training

1. Reference. AER 350-1 Training in the Army in Europe 15 FEB 07.
2. Purpose. To provide guidance on USAREUR training to be conducted by the LRMC WTU.
3. Discussion. The LRMC WTU is a medical hold unit with no combat mission and lacks Soldiers with the overall physical capabilities to accomplish combat training. As such, the WTU does not possess training resources of any note. However, there are training requirements the WTU can and must accomplish IAW Army and USAREUR regulations.
4. WTU Training Events.

A. All inclusive training. The following training requirements will be fulfilled IAW Army and USAREUR regulations by all Soldiers in the WTU.

- (1) Subversion and Espionage Directed Against the U.S. Army (SAEDA) training.
- (2) Equal Opportunity (EO), Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH), and Consideration of Others (CO2) training will be conducted in conjunction with each other quarterly.
- (3) Sexual Assault Prevention and Response will be conducted annually.
- (4) Safety briefings on motor vehicle operation, disease and injury, and substance abuse will be conducted weekly.

B. Exclusive training. The following training is reserved exclusively for the WTU cadre.

- (1) Physical fitness training. All cadre members will be expected to pass the APFT unless they have a physical profile that prohibits it.
- (2) Weapon Skills. All cadre will attend at least one M16A2 weapon range annually for qualification.

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
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(3) Leadership training. All cadre will attend required professional development courses they are eligible for in order to advance their respective careers.

5. Training/guidance. Training in removed locations will require coordination by the NCOIC with local clinics or units to train in conjunction with them. This command will tolerate training events that do not coincide with the Landstuhl Regional Medical Center WTU HQ schedule provided the following items are accomplished.

- A. The training must be accomplished within the calendar year, quarter, or month as applicable.
- B. Training accomplished in coordination with another unit must be proven with a memorandum from the training authority stating the Soldiers present were trained by name and sent to the WTU HQ Training Officer. As a courtesy the NCOIC should provide the memorandum to the training authority to sign. Utilize the enclosure as an example. If the training event has a score card, that must also be sent.
