*How have you experienced God in quiet times?
How have you heard God in the midst of Loud sounds?*

Christians have lived, worked, and worshiped in Frankfurt since before the year 794. In that year, Charlemagne held a church council here because of debates over the divinity of Jesus.

English speaking worship was first held in Frankfurt prior to 1554! Most were exiles during the Reformation. Today there are expatriates worshipping here until they return to their homes in other countries like the USA. There are also refugees worshipping here, people who have fled terror and religious persecution around the world.

- What does it mean to be quiet with God?
- Is it possible to be loud with God?
- How can you carry the quiet of meditation into the sounds of each day?

Pause in silence. Reflect on the power & provision of God. The following might help direct your thoughts & prayers:
O God, you declare your almighty power chiefly in showing mercy and pity: Grant us the fullness of your grace, that we running to obtain your promises, may become partakers of your heavenly treasure; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.
