Summary: USAG Ansbach’s Katterbach Protestant Congregation conducted the “Everest” themed Vacation Bible School (VBS) from 17 – 21 August 2015. Children learned to *Conquer Challenges with God’s Mighty Power* by visiting six ICY and interactive stations throughout each day. 104 children ranging in age from 4 to 12 registered to shout, clap, sing, dance, play, and praise their way to conquering life’s challenges. Each activity reinforced the daily Bible Point and encouraged them to HOLD ON! 41 cleared and vetted volunteers served as Bible instructors, crew leaders, snack food handlers, video facilitators, imagination station leaders, game coordinators, actors, rally leaders, and set up and tear down crew members. The Everest curriculum afforded each child the opportunity to demonstrate goodwill by collecting \$400.00 toward the purchase of Bibles for children in Thailand.
