

**EXCEPTIONAL FAMILY MEMBER PROGRAM
AND
RE-ENLISTMENT**

Developed for Soldiers who are in their re-enlistment window and have an EFM..

1. Contact your local re-enlistment NCO or career counselor for more information. You will need:
 - copy of your current orders
 - Enlisted Record Brief (ERB) or Officer Record Brief (ORB) .
2. Make sure your Family is enrolled in DEERS and TRICARE, if not already enrolled
3. Be aware you are re-enlisting for a specific amount of time or indefinite, depending on your choice in concert with your career counselor/re-enlistment NCO.
4. EFMP screening is NOT required prior to re-enlisting. IF you are attempting to re-enlist for a specific location and your EFMP enrollment is outdated, you must update the enrollment before you can re-enlist. Your EFMP enrollment must be current (within the last three years).
5. If your medical EFMP needs updating, contact the local health clinic EFMP case coordinator to schedule an appointment for the Family member who is registered in the EFMP. The health clinic will complete a new DD 2792 and forward it to the Special Needs Advisor for updating the enrollment. If the Family member is registered for educational issues, the local school will complete a new DD 2792-1 and forward it to the local health clinic EFMP case coordinator for processing.
6. Contact your local Army Community Service (ACS) Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) Manager if you have any questions concerning Family members with special medical or educational needs
