(U) PURPOSE. TASKS USAREUR SUBORDINATE AND TENANT COMMANDS AND USAREUR STAFF TO IMPLEMENT THE ARMY TRAFFIC SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM (ATSTP) IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF VEHICLE CRASHES AND ASSOCIATED INJURIES, FATALITIES, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE.

1. (U) SITUATION.

1.A. (U) ARMY COMBAT READINESS CENTER REPORTS 65 PERCENT OF ALL ACCIDENTAL SOLDIER FATALITIES OCCUR IN A MOTOR VEHICLE. THE ATSTP TARGETS THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE'S MANDATED 75 PERCENT REDUCTION IN ACCIDENTS AND FATALITIES.

1.B. (U) HQDA DIRECTS THAT ALL SOLDIERS AND DA CIVILIAN PERSONNEL COMPLY WITH ATSTP REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO REDUCE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS, BOTH ON AND OFF-DUTY.

1.C. (U) ATSTP CONSISTS OF AN ONLINE ACCIDENT AVOIDANCE COURSE (AAC), HANDS-ON MOTORCYCLE TRAINING, AND CLASSROOM TRAFFIC SAFETY TRAINING. THIS TRAINING IS IN ADDITION TO EXISTING CRITERIA USED FOR USAREUR, SETAF, OR SHAPE DRIVER'S LICENSING AND ANNUAL WINTER DRIVING TRAINING FOR ALL ARMY MOTOR VEHICLE AND NON TACTICAL VEHICLES OPERATORS.

2. (U) MISSION. USAREUR IMPLEMENTS THE ARMY TRAFFIC SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM (ATSTP) WHILE CONTINUING TO COMPLY WITH DRIVERS TRAINING IN

ACCORDANCE WITH HQDA AND USAREUR REGULATIONS AND DIRECTIVES.

3. (U) EXECUTION.

3.A. (U) CONCEPT OF THE OPERATION.

3.A.1. (U) LEADERS IDENTIFY AND TRAIN PERSONNEL REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN ATSTP. THE ONLINE ACCIDENT AVOIDANCE COURSE (AAC) HAS BECOME THE ARMY STANDARD COURSE. 3.A.1.A. (U) FOR ARMY INSTALLATIONS, POSTS, AGENCIES AND ACTIVITIES THAT CANNOT ACCESS AAC ONLINE, AN ALTERNATIVE CDROM METHOD WITH INSTRUCTOR TRAINING SUPPORT PACKAGE IS AVAILABLE THROUGH IMCOM. COORDINATE WITH IMCOM-EURO SAFETY OFFICE TO RECEIVE THE TRAINING MATERIAL, SEE 3.C.5.A. FOR POINT OF CONTACT (POC) INFORMATION. ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY METHOD DOES NOT PROVIDE AUTOMATIC CENTRAL COMPLETION REGISTRATION AND STUDENTS ARE AT RISK FOR INABILITY TO PROVE COMPLIANCE AT NEXT DUTY STATION.

3.A.1.B. (U) IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCES D THROUGH G, ALL MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS MUST SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY FOUNDATION HANDS-ON MOTORCYCLE RIDER SAFETY COURSE. UNDER ATSTP, THERE IS NO CHANGE TO THE CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR MOTORCYCLE TRAINING.

3.A.1.C. (U) REFRESHER TRAINING IS REQUIRED EVERY FOUR (4) YEARS. THE ONLINE AAC MEETS THE REFRESHER TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OF REF B AND C.

3.A.2. (U) THIS USAREUR TASKORD APPLIES TO THE FOLLOWING SUBORDINATE AND TENANT COMMANDS AND USAREUR STAFF

3.B. (U) TASKS TO SUBORDINATE AND TENANT COMMANDS AND USAREUR STAFF AND REQUEST TO IMCOM-EUROPE (PARA 3.A.2. ABOVE).

3.B.1. (U) ENSURE COMMANDERS PERFORM RISK ASSESSMENT TO DETERMINE DRIVERS MOST AT RISK. NLT 15 MAY 07 AND UPON THE ARRIVAL OF EACH NEWLY ASSIGNED INDIVIDUAL; COMMANDERS WILL PERFORM A RISK ASSESSMENT TO IDENTIFY DRIVERS MOST AT RISK. DRIVERS MOST AT RISK WILL COMPLETE THE INTERMEDIATE DRIVERS TRAINING, REGARDLESS OF AGE.

3.B.2. (U) IDENTIFY SOLDIERS UNDER THE AGE OF 26. NLT 15 MAY 07 AND QUARTERLY THEREAFTER; COMMANDERS WILL IDENTIFY ALL SOLDIERS, INCLUDING OFFICERS, UNDER AGE 26. THOSE INDIVIDUALS MUST COMPLETE THE

INTERMEDIATE DRIVERS TRAINING COURSE WHETHER OR NOT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A LICENSED DRIVER, TO ASSURE KNOWLEDGE OF STANDARDS AS A VEHICLE OCCUPANT.

3.B.3. (U) ALL INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED AS REQUIRING THE INTERMEDIATE DRIVERS COURSE MUST ALSO COMPLETE THE ADVANCED DRIVERS TRAINING COURSE CONDUCTED BY LOCAL GARRISON DURING FY07 OR NOT LATER THAN TWELVE TO EIGHTEEN MONTHS AFTER THEY HAVE COMPLETED THE INTERMEDIATE DRIVER COURSE.

3.B.4. (U) REPORT TRAINING STATUS TO USAREUR SAFETY.

3.B.5. (U) ENSURE ALL DRIVERS OF MILITARY VEHICLES, INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION MOTOR POOL (TMP) HAVE COMPLETED A DEFENSIVE-DRIVING OR ACCIDENT AVOIDANCE COURSE (AAC) WITHIN THE LAST FOUR (4) YEARS AS REQUIRED BY REF B AND VERIFY THAT MILITARY DRIVING RECORDS INDICATE THE TRAINING COMPLETION DATE. DRIVERS OF MILITARY VEHICLES WHO HAVE NOT RECEIVED ACCIDENT AVOIDANCE OR DEFENSIVE DRIVING INSTRUCTION IN THE PAST FOUR YEARS, MUST TAKE THE AAC NO LATER THAN 30 SEP 07.

3.B.6. (U) IMPLEMENT ADVANCED DRIVERS TRAINING NOT LATER THAN 12 TO 18 MONTHS AFTER INDIVIDUALS COMPLETE INTERMEDIATE DRIVERS TRAINING.

3.B.7. (U) UPON IMPLEMENTATION OF A SUPERVISOR TRAFFIC SAFETY COURSE, ALL NEWLY ASSIGNED ARMY SUPERVISORS, EXCEPT LOCAL NATIONALS, MUST RECEIVE SUPERVISOR TRAFFIC SAFETY TRAINING WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF FIRST SUPERVISORY ASSIGNMENT.
